The prayer of adoration can easily become the most neglected part of our life of prayer. Our preoccupation with ourselves and God, our concern for others, can easily take centre stage. In essence – to adore is to focus on God alone, so the necessary preparation is to clear our minds and thoughts from our own feelings, and from any sense of achieving, or using the time 'profitably'. Adoration often uses the vehicle of words in liturgy and in poetry. Music can also carry our adoration and sometimes a symbol or work of art helps to sustain our focus, but all these lead into the deepest level - Silence. *(Pause)* So although we are no longer looking for a 'result' or special feelings, when we are seeking to be silent before God we are not banishing noise but focusing on his presence, knowing that the time and space will be used by God, for we are acknowledging and welcoming a God of loving action who rejoices in our loving surrender.
